



## ATI Wah Chang NW Art & Air Festival RV and Tent Camping Rules & Regulations

### General Camping Information

- Camping spaces are \$65 per campsite.
- Campsite price includes one vehicle only (RVs with vehicle in tow is considered one vehicle). Additional vehicles are \$20 each, maximum one additional vehicle per campsite.
- Check-in begins noon, Thursday, August 25<sup>th</sup>; Check-out by noon Monday, August 29<sup>th</sup>.

### Amenities

- Volunteer Camp Hosts will be on site at all times to help place campers and answer questions.
- Free shuttle service for those requiring assistance will be provided from Camp entrance to other portions of the event throughout the day.
- Campsites are approximately 20'X50' with no hookups.
- Propane cooking grills are welcome; open fires and charcoal grills are prohibited.

### Facilities

- Portable toilets and a wash station will be provided.
- Potable water tank will be on site.
- Garbage and recycle containers will be on site
- Dump facilities: First Stop Auto, 1119 Commercial Way (only blocks away). There is a coupon in Welcome Bag for \$1 off.
- Showers are available at the Linn County Fair Grounds, Cascade Building. They will be open daily from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. There is no cost for their use.

### Camp Rules and Regulations

1. All campsites must be reserved and paid for in advance.
2. All campers must check-in with camp hosts.
3. Camp hosts are there to help you and answer your questions. They are there to make sure your stay is pleasant and safe, however they have the authority to evict uncooperative guests.
4. No check-in before noon on Thursday, August 25, 2011.
5. All campsites must be vacated by noon Monday, August 29, 2011.
6. Once your RV is parked or tent is set up, you will not be able to move/remove the RV or tent until Sunday August 28<sup>th</sup> after 1 p.m.
7. All vehicles and equipment must be kept within your camp site.
8. All roads in the camping area are considered fire access roads. Vehicles and other property blocking the fire access roads will be removed at the owners expense.
9. Alcohol is permitted inside your vehicle or within your campsite only. Campers are not permitted to wander with open containers.
10. Pets are not allowed on the Balloon Lift Off or Night Glow fields.
11. Owners must pick up after their pets.

12. Protect your belongings and lock up your vehicles and valuables while in the campground. The NW Art & Air Festival, camp host, or any individual or organization connected to this event are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property of any kind.
13. NO FIRES are allowed! This includes campfires, charcoal grills, portable fire pits, and other open flame devices. Propane stoves and grills are the only exception.
14. No Fireworks are allowed.
15. Quiet time is one hour after the last event of the day until 6:30 a.m. in the morning. Please be considerate of your neighbors and observe the established quiet time.
16. Generators are allowed as long as they are not overly noisy. Their use during quiet time is discouraged but will be permitted for those with medical needs only. Festival management reserves the right to prohibit the use of any generator at any time.
17. No banners or flags may fly from your campsite that might obstruct vision.
